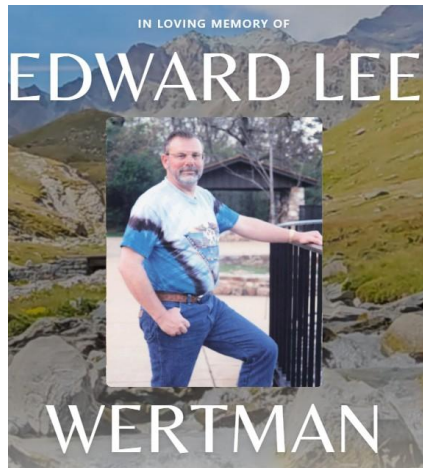




Obituary
